RE : WHERE TO SEND DONATIONS FOR VERLIN & DEBBIE ANDERSON'S CONTINUING MINISTRY

Dear Friends and Ministry Partners,

Since departing from FWBIM in August, we have considered service with three separate mission agencies. All three vibrantly represent Christ around the world, but each with a different focus through which to serve. After much reflection, consultation, and prayer, we delight to unite our efforts with Christian Health Service Corps (www.healthservicecorps.org). Their specialized focus is sending medical missionaries and Community Health Evangelism (CHE) workers. This matches the calling the Lord has given us. We continue as Free Will Baptists in distinctives and covenant, while increasing partnership capacities with Ivorian, Ghanaian, and American organizations to share the Good News through CHE (pronounced *chay*).

Christian Health Service Corps (CHSC) receives donations to our ministry account #0118 beginning Monday, December 16, 2013. As a growing 501(c)(3) charitable organization, the contributions on our behalf are tax deductible. CHSC adheres to [Evangelical Council for Financial Accountability guidelines](#) for accreditation. Any online donation is securely processed by Acceptiva. Visa, MasterCard, Discover, and eCheck are accepted. A 3% transaction fee is charged against the donation to cover credit and bank card fees and other processing costs. If you can, consider adding 3% to your donation amount so that 100% of your donation goes to us. **To give online, go to www.healthservicecorps.org, select Missionaries, and select Verlin & Debbie Anderson on the drop-down menu. Our return to Cote d'Ivoire is planned for late 2014, or early 2015, after reporting to our many faithful supporters. We need to celebrate together the saving and healing of souls through churches, clinics, and a university. All has been possible as a result of our partnership with you. Eight thousand dollars of average monthly support (\$8,000) and an accumulated cash balance of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) is necessary before we return to reside in Cote d'Ivoire for four years. That budget is 20% LESS than our former. If 100% of those supporting our ministry through budget and designated giving in 2013 give through the CHSC, our *quick* return will be possible. Pray with us for the retention of support. Currently we live on savings and reimbursements to let our support account grow as we complete this transition.

Rejoicing at the enormous door of opportunity open before us, and trusting the Lord to provide,
