We grieve with his Abengourou family, church, clinic, and denomination. He served in multiple roles, including those of CHE team leader, clinic administrator, and active church member. He and his wife were expecting their first child in six months. We came to know him better as CHE began to expand in the

nation. He helped us train teams in Bondoukou, villages, and at a university in Abidjan. Pasquier was a joy to know and with whom to serve others. He enabled many Christian NGO and churches to more effectively witness and serve. The void he leaves is large, but thankfully we know the Lord does not take someone without creating opportunities for His glory to be seen in other ways. Beyond all the talents he offered in many settings, we will sorely miss him as a friend. He's been a "brother of another mother." Pray that his legacy will bring many to a greater understanding of the Jesus he served here and now serves in heavenly places.

Planning for the September 2015 CHE university training continues with the importance of having alternate trainers apparent. Ask the Lord to provide substitute trainers and to give wisdom as we eliminate 7 hours of training.
