As you know, news came out today about the Supreme Court overturning *Roe v Wade*, putting the legislative responsibility of handling abortion access back into the hands of the states as opposed to being recognized as a constitutional right of all women across the whole nation. It's always been important at our church to pray over things like this and do our best to support safe, biblical alternatives to abortion because God values *all* life, including the life of the unborn. The news that came out today is *good* and worthy of praise and thanksgiving to God.

I encourage you to continue in your compassion, kindness, and empathy--not just toward the unborn, but also toward women and families in difficult life situations that cause them to consider abortion. And for children born into the world to mothers who don't want them or can't take care of them. I can't imagine the loneliness and desperation they must feel, but part of our calling as disciples of Jesus is to pray and care for others in their most lonely and desperate moments.

I hope that our summer series in the book of Romans is helping you see life from an eternal perspective even more and that this perspective helps you love those around you in the same manner that Jesus does. Jesus meets people right where they are and his loving kindness draws them to himself. He also empowers His Church to love, serve, and care *well*. I pray that you do that on the heels of this news in our country.
